This part of the plan explains how we will make things better.	×
We want equality groups to feel welcome when they talk to us.	
And we want them to use our help more.	
We want people from these groups to be able to manage their careers better.	
We also want people in these groups to make better decisions about their careers.	×
And have a good experience moving from school to more education, to training or to work.	



We also want everyone to be treated the same.	
That means people should not be judged unfairly because of who they are.	
It also means those people should have more options for work.	
And that everyone can have the career they want.	
We also want people to understand their rights in education, training and work.	EDUCATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2016 (UK) Human Rights Act 1 OTHE Employment Act
They should be able to know if they are being discriminated against.	
And be able to fight that.	



We also want people to be able to choose how they develop their careers.	
Now let's look at how we plan to do this.

It means we will continue to do these things.	
But we will also look at what we have done to see if we can do it any better in the future.	



Giving our staff the skills to help people	
We have a website for our staff where they can find information to help them do their job better.	Welcome

Letting people in equality groups know about apprenticeships	
Skills Development Scotland has an apprenticeship team.	



An apprenticeship is where people learn, train and work at the same time.	
You can do an apprenticeship in a lot of different things, including working in shops, hotels, restaurants or offices.	
One kind of apprenticeship can be done while young adults are still at school.	
This is called a foundation apprenticeship.	
A foundation apprenticeship lets young people learn a job while they are still at school.	
We want more people from equality groups to join this foundation apprenticeship.	
We think this will make those people think about more choices of possible jobs.	
We have already started doing this.

There are other apprenticeships in work and colleges or universities.	
People on modern apprenticeships work, get paid and study at college or at a training centre.	E C C C C C C C C C C C C C C C C C C C
People on graduate apprenticeships get a degree in the subject they are studying.	
We want more young people, and their parents or carers, to know about these choices.	
We want the number of people from equality groups joining these apprenticeships to grow.	
We have already started doing this.

We really want young women to think about apprenticeships in STEM.	
STEM stands for science, technology, engineering and mathematics.	
We want as many young women as there are young men to think about working in STEM.	
We will work with female pupils in schools to do this.

There is a lot of help across Scotland for people from equality groups.	



This help includes training, support and funding.	
We will work with the people running them to let people from equality groups know about this help.	
This will help those people start apprenticeships.	
We want to see a lot more people from equality groups take part in these.

Using facts and figures to help us do the best we can	

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We will work with our staff to find out what facts and figures we already have.
