Introduction

Almost 145,000 learners across Scotland will receive their SQA results on Tuesday 8 August 2023.

Once again, Skills Development Scotland's (SDS) Results Helpline will be there to offer information, advice and guidance to Scotland's young people and their parents and carers.

They will have access to information on course vacancies at UK colleges and universities, Confirmation and Clearing, advice about Foundation, Modern and Graduate Apprenticeships, jobs, volunteering, or staying on at school.
