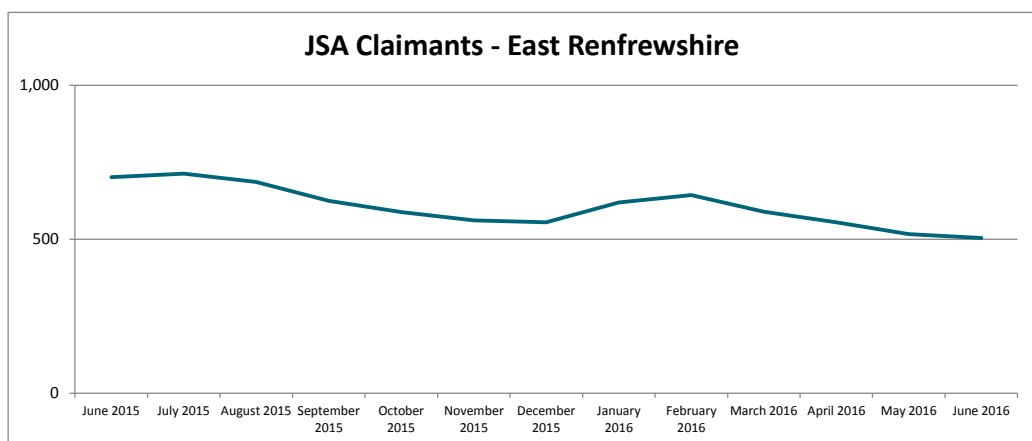

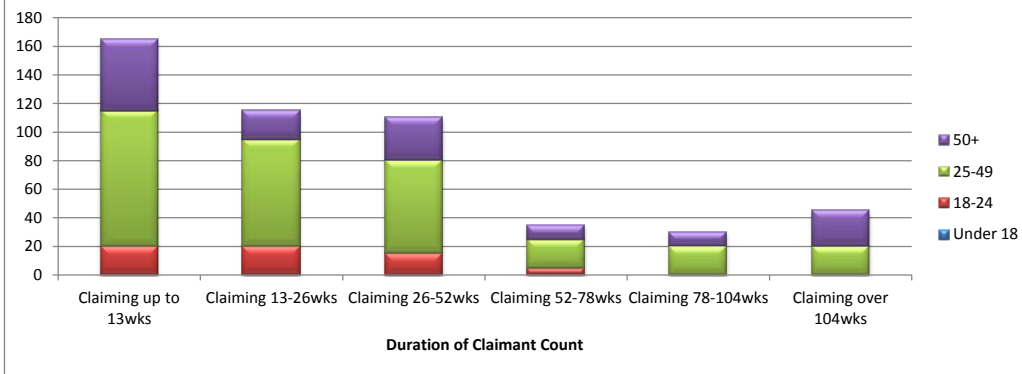

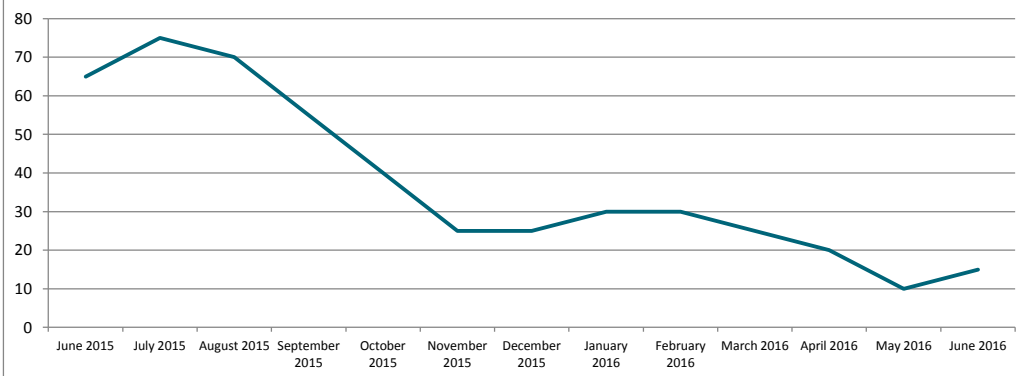

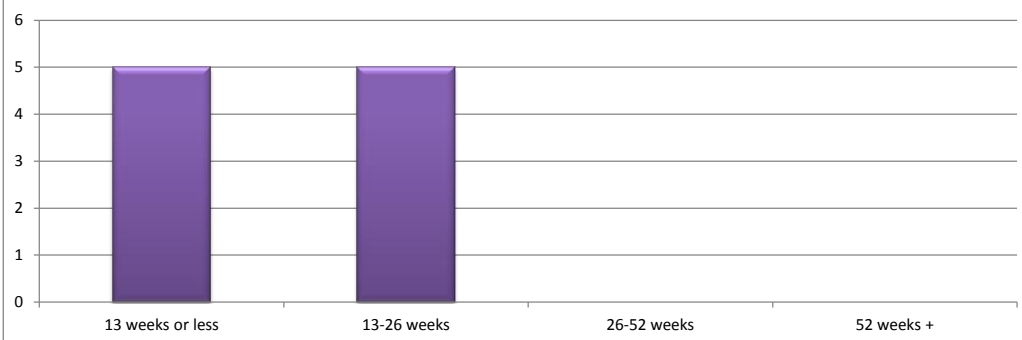

As of June 2015, ONS have changed the definition of the Claimant Count to include all out of work Universal Credit claimants. As a result, JSA Claimant Count has been renamed to indicate that its scope is now limited to claimants of Jobseeker's Allowance only and does not contain the additional Universal Credit claimants now included in the new headline Claimant Count definition.
