Local Partner Services

Dumfries and Galloway local partners can provide a wide range of services and support for individuals facing the prospect of unemployment.

Advice - Consumer, debt, benefits, council tax, reducing fuel bills, housing and employment.

Education and training - Our local colleges and universities offer a range of Further Education and Higher Education courses and training opportunities as well as employability support.

Employability and skills - Intensive support to remove barriers into employment or training. One to one or group support for help with CVs, interviews, training opportunities and other employability needs. Weekly work clubs with full support and access to computer to focus on job hunting.

Libraries - Photocopying, access to newspapers and magazines for job search, computers for public use, access to Open Learning, access to the internet.

Self-employment - Advice, support and training to consider and/or move into selfemployment.

Social Work Services - Support services for families in crisis, mental health issues, addiction, dependant care, disability, etc.

Volunteering - Anyone can be a volunteer, you do not need previous experience or qualifications. Your own particular skills, experience and interests will be welcomed.

Lifelong Learning Service - A universal service for those who need it most and working with other partners supports essential skills for life and work, including literacy, numeracy, communication, self confidence and English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL).
