
There are lots of ways to get involved, and whilst this toolkit has specific guidance for schools, employers and career practitioners, any organisation that helps support career choices can get involved.




Join the DYW Live! Scottish Careers Week Programme


Join or host an event

With an SDS Careers Adviser and DYW Coordinator in every state secondary school in Scotland, your school careers team can work with you to develop events and activities that best suit the needs of your pupils. From aligning your career fairs to Scottish Careers Week to hosting events for parents, there are lots of ways to get involved. You can request speakers and support for events via:

- My World of Work Marketplace: learn about the world of work with offers from employers tailored to learning outcomes. Search, book and confirm places for your class direct through Marketplace.
- Founders4Schools: find local employers matching the interests of your students and invite them to an event at your school.
- DYW Live: join the live sessions that support learners' development of employability skills, career pathways and industry connections.

SDS and a range of partners will also be running events during Scottish Careers Week.

Whether it's careers fairs or webinars, there's lots to get involved with. And lots of the action is taking place virtually, meaning that more schools than ever can get involved.

Join in on social and share your career journey




It's easy to join in, simply post two photos which best sum up the start of your career journey and where you are now. We also have free, easy to use templates for you to use to make your post really stand out.
