

DYW Sector Labour Market Information (LMI)

National Series of Online Events 2024

**The following online sessions will be delivered from January 2024 through to June 2024
(all sessions will run from 3.45pm – 4.45pm)**

Financial Services	The session will cover the emerging opportunities and challenges within Financial Services. It will explore labour market intelligence, outline the current strategic direction, and provide an opportunity to hear from a Financial Services organisation currently engaged in schools. This session is an opportunity to better understand the skills landscape in Financial Services.
Engineering	The session will cover latest LMI on the Engineering sector with inputs from Stakeholders such as the trade bodies Scottish Engineering and Space Scotland. There will be the opportunity to build connections for engagement in education to assist skills and recruitment.
Energy	This session will look at future jobs demand and the type of roles/skills required across the energy sector as it transitions towards net zero, including Offshore Wind, Hydrogen and Carbon Capture. The session will have input from employers such as BP to explore opportunities for education and collaboration across skills and recruitment.
Forestry	The session will cover latest LMI and information on workforce challenges and opportunities on the Forestry sector with inputs from Scottish Forestry and the opportunity to build connections for engagement in education to assist skills and recruitment.
Tourism	This session will provide an overview of the skills challenges and opportunities facing the tourism and hospitality sector and key labour market information. It will include information on the work of the Springboard Charity in Scotland and provide a perspective from industry representatives.
Life & Chemical Sciences	This session will provide an overview of the key drivers, opportunities and skills requirements for the Life and Chemical Sciences sector within Scotland covering topics such as the transition to net zero, automation and digitalisation, and the impact of the ageing population. We will be joined by industry representatives from areas such as Industrial Biotechnology and Pharmaceutical Services.
