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UNIVERSITY ADMISSION & ENTRY CRITERIA 2026-2027

Each university sets its own entry criteria often reflecting levels of difficulty within a course OR competition for places. It's essential to research and compare course entry criteria and to be aware of these common entry policies:

PATHWAYS BETWEEN COLLEGE & UNIVERSITY 2026-27

What is Articulation?

Articulation is a formal progression pathway between a college Higher National Certification (HNC) or Diploma (HND) to a degree, allowing students to progress to the next level of study:

- HNC (SCQF 7) direct entry to 2nd year of a degree (SCQF 8)
- HND (SCQF 8) direct entry to 3rd year of a degree (SCQF 9)

College & universities may have formal **Articulation Agreements** where courses are aligned for smooth transition. Students get access to support and resources from both institutions.

Some Articulation Agreements or **Associate Student Schemes** include guaranteed degree places for those who pass the HNC/D

SCOTTISH WIDER ACCESS PROGRAMME (SWAP) 2026-27

What is SWAP?

SWAP access programmes are for adults who left school with few or no qualifications, and who are looking to get into higher education. All programmes are delivered by colleges with progression opportunities to SWAP partner universities.

Specialist programmes include Access to Allied Health Professions, Nursing, Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy and Vet Medicine.

Places are not guaranteed, but SWAP is recognised by Scotland's universities.

SWAP is available across Scotland, but delivery is split across two regions SWAP East and SWAPWest. Eligibility criteria differ slightly between these areas. Each SWAP partnership has dedicated routes into degree subjects from their access programmes.

Not all colleges offer all routes. SWAP websites have information on which programmes are offered at each college.

There is no upper or lower age limit to apply as eligibility is based on educational background.

If you left school with **no qualifications higher than National 5** then you need to have been out of high school for **3-years**

SWAP is **not suitable for** those who already have a degree or international students

SWAP EAST - If you left school with **Highers or have a HNC** then you need to have been out of high school for **3-years**

SWAPWEST - If you left school with **Highers or have a HNC** then you need to have been out of high school for **5-years**

APPLYING

SWAP programmes run for one academic year, from around the end of August through to May/June.

The programmes are run by colleges, so applications are managed through the normal college online application system. Programmes will open for applications at the same time as other qualifications, typically around January depending on the individual college.

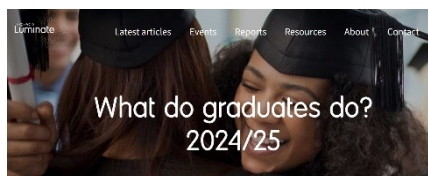
